

Board Approves Training School

State's Action Comes Ten Days After Inspection

Youngstown College has been placed on the list of approved colleges for teachers' training, according to word received here from B. O. Skinner, director of the state department of education.

"Dr. W. W. Boyd, college counselor and inspector, has made a report on your institution, and I want to congratulate you on the success you are making," Mr. Skinner wrote. "I am very happy, therefore, to endorse the recommendation which he makes for your approval," he continued.

"Placing Youngstown College on this list means that prospective teachers in this district can obtain complete training without traveling to a larger school", Director Howard W. Jones commented when notified of the education department's action.

Dr. Boyd inspected the college Oct. 9. In his report he commended Youngstown College for keeping teaching standards high during the depression.

The new department of education here is under the direction of Dr. George M. Wilcox, formerly of Heidelberg college. Nearly all of the classes in this department are enjoying large enrollments.
