Campus Mourns Death Of Prof. John H. Cramer

Funeral services were held for the late Professor John H. Cramer at King Funeral Home at 2:30 p.m. today. Dr. Cramer died suddenly, apparently of a heart attack, at a Nu Sigma Rho rush party in Lexington Settlement Tuesday night while engaged in party festivities with the fraternity to which he was advisor.

The 46-year-old expert of Lincolniana died just six days after his third book on Lincoln was published October 20. Mr. Cramer has been on the Youngstown College faculty since last February. He lived at 323 Princeton Ave., Hubbard.

When Dr. Cramer collapsed the police ambulance was called and the crewmen made futile attempts to revive him. He was pronounced dead on arrival at St. Elizabeth Hospital.
