

U. S. State Department Selects Dr. E. B. Smith For Seminar Training

Dr. E. B. Smith, professor of history at Youngstown College, is one of a small group of professors and outstanding graduate students who have been selected by the U. S. State Department to receive a seminar training course with the department in Washington during July and August.

The selection of students for the course was based on scholastic achievement in the study of matters related to foreign affairs and the purpose of the program is to acquaint those participating with the inner workings of the State Department and at the same time enable them to serve by completing projects involving independent research on actual present-day problems of the department.
