Magazine Accepts E. B. Smith's Article

The American Historical Review, leading periodical of the history profession, has accepted an article by Dr. E. B. Smith, Jr., member of the history department faculty of Youngstown College, for publication.

The article, entitled "Thomas Hart Benton, Southern Realist," is a revision of the paper which Dr. Smith presented before the annual convention of the American Historical Association in 1950.

It deals with the efforts of Senator Thomas Hart Benton of Missouri to lead the South away from the extremist position which led to the American Civil War and is a study of the larger, problem of maintaining sanity, realism, and moderation in an era of exaggerated emotional conflict.

Dr. Smith did his doctoral work under Prof. Avery O. Craven, a leading authority on the coming of the Civil War, and was Prof. Craven's assistant at the University of Chicago for three years.
