

# L. A. Deeze Appointed New Dean

Louis A. Deesz, combustion engineer for Republic Steel Corp. of this district, has been appointed dean of the evening engineering school of Youngstown college, according to an announcement made by President Howard W. Jones. The appointment was effective immediately.

Deesz, who has been teaching courses in electricity and mathematics in evening school for the past two years, has his bachelor of science in electrical engineering degree from Carnegie Institute of Technology.

He has been instrumental in securing many valuable gifts of equipment from industrial concerns in this district for use in the mechanical and electrical laboratories.

Deesz has already set up practical curriculums in mechanical, chemical and metallurgical subjects, especially for men who are now employed. These courses may be completed in five regular school years, or in four years by attending two summer sessions.
