

# \$400 Scholarship Given By Dunbrik

Youngstown College is the recipient of an annual \$400 scholarship, a gift of the Youngstown Dunbrik Company, Inc., to be awarded to an engineering student who plans a career in the building industry.

The scholarship idea was originated by Rene DiPiero, manager of Youngstown Dunbrik, who sent a Christmas letter to the patrons of his company, suggesting that they might wish to have the scholarship established as a substitute for the token gift which the company usually sent to its patrons.

To be known as "The Building Industry Scholarship - Youngstown Dunbrik Company." the scholarship will be awarded for the first time this spring effective in the fall term, to a Youngstown College engineering student selected by a committee consisting of George Shutrump, president of the Mahoning Valley Builders Association; Chris Bode, Jr., President of the Mahoning Valley Home Builders Association; and William Moore, agent of Bricklayer's Union, Local No. 8.

The DiPiero family has been well represented at Youngstown College, with five of the seven children in the family having attended the college. DiPiero is a former student, as were his brothers Dr. Herbert DiPiero, chiropodist; John DiPiero, secretary and treasurer of the Youngstown Dunbrik Company, Inc.; Mrs. Bruno Tursini (Sue DiPiero) of 428 Sherwood Ave., and Philip DiPiero, now a major in the U.S. Air Force on the military science faculty of Cornell University, who received his degree of Bachelor of Science in Education from Youngstown College in 1947.
