

Work in Progress On Old Rayen Building

As part of the planned postwar expansion to take care of the increasing enrollment, the William Rayen School of Engineering is becoming a reality. Remodeling to fit the needs of our engineering department has been in progress for three months.

Included in the \$120,000 remodeling cost is the cleaning and painting of the exterior and the entire redecoration of the interior. The smaller rooms have disappeared with modern classrooms in their place. The basement has been modernized to hold the 400,000-pound steel-testing machine.

When completed this new building will hold 200 day and 300 night pupils. The building may be ready for use at the first of the new year.
