President Bush visits campus

President Bush led a panel discussion on community health centers in Spotlight Arena Theater in Bliss Hall on May 25. It is the first time a sitting president has visited YSU in the campus' 96-year history. About 250 invited guests, including several YSU trustees and administrators, attended the 45-minute event, which attracted dozens of national news reporters. While the president was inside Bliss Hall, a crowd of about 200 protesters and supporters gathered outside, waving signs and chanting slogans.

The president's visit resulted in prominent mentions of YSU in newspapers from New York to Seattle. The New York Times, USA Today, Washington Post, Chicago Tribune and the Seattle Post-Intelligencer were among the newspapers that included YSU in their stories.
