Subject: **Minutes of April 3, 1996, meeting (12-noon - 12:50 p.m.)**

1. Minutes of February 15, 1996 were approved. It was noted that the meeting of February 29 had been cancelled.

2. Discussion on changing day and time of future meetings, possibly to Friday, 12-2 p.m. ASC members should inform Singler of best meeting time.

However, next meeting kept at Wednesday, April 10 at noon.

3. Singler reported that three motions of ASC to the Senate passed without change.

4. Agenda for Spring was reviewed.

a) gather data on upper division/lower division distribution. Memo to be sent to department chairs.

b) copy of "non-matriculated admission" proposal to be sent to ASC members.

c) "credit for experiences" comments: In the Transfer module, YSU is required to accept credits. Six of thirteen Ohio universities have a policy. Who would conduct a panel review? What are the guidelines? Experiences are primarily focused on skills (e.g. computer literacy). How would we accommodate experiences of non-traditional students? It might be best to first establish a limit on the number of credits allowed (e.g. 8 QH) and change later if warranted.

Morrison volunteered to search out the comments recorded in minutes of previous Senate meeting.

5. If time permits, the ASC may look at grade requirements for good standing at a later date. See 95-96 Bulletin p. 59-60.

6. At the next meeting the ASC intends to look at the transfer of honors credit relative to articulation agreements with community colleges (see attached memo previously distributed).
