#### I. Programs Reviewed.

##### A. Physical Therapy -

Bob Frampton went over details of program which is actually a phase out of Bachelor's program to a new 3 + 3 Master's program which will be introduced as a new semester program later.

The program was **approved**.

##### B. Pre-Kindergarten Education program.

Louise Pavia went over history of Pre-Kindergarten program.

The program was **approved in February** and that is still the position of the committee. As soon as courses are finished circulating the program will be sent on to the senate.

##### C. Communication & Theater proposals.

- The B.A. in Telecommunication Studies (#99-44) is being **returned** for the clarification of hours in the major. Total semester hours on page 2 says 29 hours while the number of hours in the major at the top of page 3 says 40. We cannot figure the discrepancy. Please fill in correct hours and return to the chair.
- The BFA program in Music Theater (#99-45) was **approved**.
- The BA in Communication Studies (#99-46) is being **returned**. Not all of the existing program and what it turns into under semesters is shown on the programs form. For example what do courses 856 and 857 turn into in the semester form. It's hard to see if they are dropped or what.
- The BFA program in Theater Production/Performance was **approved pending** the clarification of what courses are included in the quarter selection of "16 hours taken from:" The theater 868 and 869, art, english, and history selections are not found on the programs form in the first column for quarters.
- The BA in Theater program is being **returned**. On the summary for the programs form on p. 3, 18 hours of support courses are listed, but what these support courses are is unclear. If these are an integral part of the program then they should be included on the programs form in the semesters column.
