Requests by Mr. Eddy of the History Department for the approval of mimeographed outlines for Histories 105, 106, 201, 202, 333, and from Mr. Bare for approval of a syllabus for Psychology 201 were submitted. It was moved by Mr. Westenfield that the outlines submitted be approved for sale through the Book Store subject to written approval of the outlines from the head of the department involved; seconded by Mr. Wilcox. After further discussion, Mr. Westenfield amended the original motion to the effect that Mr. Eddy's request be approved on the basis of his statement to the Chairman of the committee that Mr. Gould had approved the outline, but that Mr. Bare's request be approved only after the receipt of a written statement from Mr. Mayer. Amendment was seconded by Mr. Wilcox and the entire motion was unanimously approved by the committee.
