Nursing supervision prevented Sharon Shipton from attending. She supplied reviews and comments for this meeting's business.

A quorum was achieved.

I. Preliminary Business.

- a. Committee positions Nancy Sweeney to be committee representative for Education. The committee will also need a new Arts & Science representative.
- b. A brief discussion of Senate Procedures ensued in light of the pace of Q2S transition.

II. Programs Reviewed.

A. Communication & Theater proposals.

- The BFA program in Theater Production/Performance was approved.
- The BA in Theater program was approved.

The committee still awaits response on the B.A. in Telecommunication studies and the B.A. in Communication Studies.

B. Political Science.

The Political Science proposal is being **returned**. The committee could not see how hours add up to get 32 for the major! This should be made apparent on the programs form where combinations and selections of courses should be made clear. We should be able to add X+X+X=32 on the programs form.

If the remaining 14 hours after 2 courses in American Government, 2 courses in Comparative and International Politics, 1 Political Thought, and 1 Capstone are general electives a space on the programs formed should be utilized to say so.

Also to be addressed are if there are any support courses required from other disciplines or departments.

I draw your attention to no. 2 on our Academic Program Proposal Checklist enclosed.

C. History.

The Q2S History proposal is being **returned**. Course names and numbers in both quarter and semester format need to be shown on the programs form. It is important that the committee see how the program translates from quarters to semesters at a glance. Your numbers add up understandably to 39, but we can't see the courses in the detail required on the form. Place courses and their numbers in the B, C, and D groupings on the form.

I draw your attention to no. 2 on our Academic Program Proposal Checklist enclosed.

The Q2S proposal for the certificate in Historic Preservation is likewise being **returned**, though once the History proposal is clarified, we're sure that this one will be clear as well. Please include on the programs form the specific courses that are central to this certificate.

D. Social Work.

The Social Work proposal has been approved.

The Nursing Home Administration proposal is being **returned**. It is still raising questions with the committee. The following are the issues involved.

- The variability of hours in two courses required (AHLTH 4801 and SOCIO 4821) makes the total hours possible in the major appear variable as well. Are the total number of possible hours in the major actually varying somewhere between 62 and 71? Please clarify on the summary sheet.
- Also the number of hours on the summary sheet still don't appear to add up properly. If we're reading this right, 67 (or number considering bullet above) + GER (even considering a double dip for support courses) = 112. It looks more like 12 to 15 hours of free electives instead of 24. Please clarify on the summary sheet and make sure the courses and hours match on the programs form on previous pages.
