- Committee received packet of information on SB140 students and SB140 programs at other Ohio universities. This information will be discussed at next meeting.
- 3. Van Siatras addressed the committee regarding the SB140 program at Y.S.U. Among his comments were the following:
 - Y.S.U. tends to adhere to the upper 20% of HS class requirement rather than 3.2 gradepoint. GPA of SB140 students are higher than 3.2.
 - -- The admission procedure was described as follows:
 - a) Process is initiated by high schools in March
 - b) Applicants are interviewed and tested during April and May.
 - c) Determination of admission occurs during June and July.
 - -- It was stressed that the process is very timeconsuming and that demands will increase if program grows. Y.S.U. interviews each applicant.
 - -- HS curriculum directors are offended that Y.S.U. allows students to take courses available in HS.
 - -- Parents seem to be looking for tuition free college credit.
 - -- The program was patterned after program in Minnesota targeted to rural school districts.
 - -- What is broke?
 - a) Suggest controls on CH taken.
 - b) Nobody at Y.S.U. is specifically designated to oversee the program.
 - c) The program will continue to grow it if is not restricted.
 - d) If program continues to grow more support will be needed in terms of administration and advising.
