JOINT MEETING OF THE ACADEMIC STANDARDS AND CURRICULUM COMMITTEES.

This meeting was called to discuss the recommendations of the joint committee subcommittee on science requirements dated May 14, 1957. There was much preliminary discussion especially of the proposal for a course in general mathematics. It was agreed that the twelve-hour sequence proposed by the subcommittee would require extended discussion, and regular meetings will be held on alternate Thursdays beginning in January, 1958.

Among other suggestions was one that the new sequence, if approved, be accepted as meeting the requirement for the B.A. degree for those students who shift from candidacy for another degree to a B.A. candidacy after they have completed the new sequence.
