I. Programs Reviewed.

A. History.

The History and Historic Preservation programs were **approved pending** the inclusion of the total number of hours on the last page of the programs form (see enclosed) and a statement added there that these courses will all be 3 hour courses in the semester format. The same applies to the Historic Preservation form.

B. Psychology.

The proposal to drop the B.S. in Psychology was discussed by the committee. How will such a drop affect other medical oriented programs which may assume the B.S. in Phychology as standard for their needs? No action has yet been taken.

The Psychology program is being **returned**. Turn the program on the first page into a section by section running explanation on the programs form. The form as is is an inventory when the committee needs to see course groupings in the different areas and the hours required in the different areas. Total hours in the different selections should then add up easily to arrive at the total number of hours at the end of the form.

The purpose and operation of the Psychology Honors program flummoxed the committee. It is likewise being **returned**. It appears to be an appendage to the regular program, but the connection needs to be made clear. Total hours are listed as 38 on the summary sheet, but 13-16 are seen at the end of the programs form. Perhaps the regular program needs to appear here emphasizing that this is an appendage to it. The substitutions this special program uses in lieu of the regular program are unclear. Also, provide a rationale for an honors program in Psychology when a separate honors system can be accessed university-wide.
