I realize that at this time of year both the UPD and UCD are greatly busy and must pick and choose issues that are raised, such as Physical Therapy's Program change. Although the program change was passed through the Senate, I feel that the issue I raised has not been settled. Every program has the right to add and drop courses. Hence, the Physical Therapy Program dropping Statistics 714 should not be a problem. However, I still have a problem with the statement that is attached: "... important probability and statistics principles will be taught in ... AHLTH806."

I believe that courses like AHLTH 806 should not be allowed to change their course description "on the fly." Such statements about AHLTH 806 should be accompanied by a curriculum change in that course. The undergraduate bulletin is a contract which describes what is being taught at this University; it should not be violated.
