MINUTES OF THE ACADEMIC STANDARDS COMMITTEE

December 2, 1954

1. Dean Smith discussed the status of student employment, especially in regard to faculty privileges. The problem of parking stickers is a particularly critical one. Mr. Dykema asked for suggestions on dealing with the problem of requests for extra commencement tickets. The committee members offered several suggestions for dealing with the difficulty.

2. A discussion was begun on the problem presented by Summer Saturday classes. The solutions suggested were: 1) That Saturday morning classes be eliminated and only two 110 minute periods be scheduled in the morning. 2) That classes begin at 7 a.m. and three 110 minute periods be scheduled between seven o'clock and one o'clock. 3) That each of the two Summer sessions be extended to six weeks and the present morning schedule be retained but with the elimination of Saturday classes. No decision was reached and committee members were asked to discuss the alternatives with other faculty members. In the course of the discussion a great deal of comment was made on the difficulty of getting students to arrive promptly at early classes.
