- 1. The first Draft Proposal, Department-College Goal Setting dated October 24, 1984, was discussed.
- Point agreed up informally:
 - a. All departments should have goals as described.
 - b. There should be some sort of form or framework which would be used in the initial stages of goal setting.
 - c. This proposal is intended to be included in the next Academic Master Plan along with a statement from the Administration that it will be used.
 - d. The key point of the proposal is objective 2: "...goals which are recognized and approved by the administration. These should be used during budgetary considerations."
 - e. The proposal should include a deadline of, say, one academic year for the entire goal setting process, initial phase.

3. Next steps:

- a. Dr. Khawaja will write a rough draft of a framework to use in the initial stages of the goal setting.

- c. Dr. Brown will prepare a second draft of the proposal making some changes disussed at the meeting.
