1. Minutes of January 4, 1996, were noted.
2. Singler distributed a working draft of a proposed change in the residency requirement. After discussion, the following proposal was approved:

Proposed Policy

"The last 30 quarter hours leading to an associate degree and the last 45 quarter hours leading to a baccalaureate degree must be completed at YSU. A minimum of 10 quarter hours in the concentration area for the associate degree, and 16 quarter hours of credits comprising the major for the baccalaureate degree must be earned in residence. A minimum of 28 quarter hours of upper division credit for the baccalaureate degree must be earned in residence. Exceptions must be approved by the Office of the Provost."

Comments from the Dean's Council and the colleges (via the Deans) would be requested for consideration at the February 1 meeting of ASC.

3. Distribution of notes on admission policies at YSU and on credit-for-experiences. Discussion occurred and included.
  - a) What are guidelines and procedures regarding AP credit and general exam CLEP.
  - b) What do other four year universities do about admission of students who are home-schooled or are from non-chartered schools.
  - c) The need to distinguish between credit-by-exam and credit-for-experiences.
  - d) Copies to ASC members of : Transfer Practices for Allied Health Professions; credit by exam guidelines and procedure; YSU flyer on non-traditional credit.
4. Admission of students from non-chartered schools and home-schools. Discussion continued. A working draft is to be prepared for the next meeting.
