Tuesday at four seems the least unsatisfactory hour for meetings of the committee. The first session will be October 2 at 4 p.m. in Main 406.

The following items have been added to the agenda given in item 7 of the minutes of 2 May 1962:

1. Statement in catalog restricting the language acceptable for the degree requirement to those offered in course at Youngstown University. This is essentially 7 (4) of the 2 May minutes .
2. Reconsideration of the criteria for the honors' and dean's lists to reduce the number on those lists.
3. Establishment of a policy about acceptance of transfer credit for television courses.
4. Consideration of the re-establishment of mid-semester grades to guarantee that students be given an indication of how well they are doing, and postponement of WF until after such test is given.
