- 1. Mr. D'Isa presented (in duplicated form) the report of his subcommittee (Dean Smith, Col. Bestor, D'Isa), whose function was to attempt clarification of the statement on page h3 of the 1962-3 catalog, "Modifications for R.O.T.C. Students". After considerable discussion the committee instructed Mr. D'Isa to consider with his committee the possibility of eliminating the modifications entirely or at least the ones in section (b).
- 2. The remainder of the meeting was dewoted to discussing the Advanced Placement Program, especially with regard to our policy toward it.

 Mr. Miner commented on the paper of a student who had been tested by A.P.E. in English. Mr. Beelen, who teaches the Advanced Placement Course in history at Poland High School, gave some account of his experiences with the program and the examination. Mr. Behen summarized our policy up to the present.

Mr. Beelen was invited to the next meeting at which the discussion will be continued.

Mr. Miner has drawn up a statement of proposed policy which he has sent to Mr. Behen.
