- 2. Committee reconsidered letter received from Academic Affairs Committee dated June 3, 1980. The following recommendations were made:
 - a. Rule 1 Committee moved and seconded that eligibility for honors day consist of 18 q.h. completed at YSU for freshman; 36 q.h. for sophomores; 54 q.h. for juniors and 72 q,h. for seniors.
 - b. Rule 2 Committee requests a clarification of term "previous academic year". It was suggested that the term "current academic year" be substituted. Committee recommends that students be in attendance either fall or winter quarter preceding Honors Day.
 - c. Rule 3 Committee recommends that current formulation for Honors Day selection be retained, namely the top 1% of each school.
- 3. Committee recommends that current rule for Honors Day selection be more specific and state that selection is based on 1% of total enrollment by school as indicated by fall quarter 14 day enrollment figures.
