Dr. William Jenkins was elected Chair of the Committee for the 1988-89 year.

OLD BUSINESS: A request for a new policy regarding student course schedules was discussed. Stan Guzell had suggested that the Committee consider "whether or not the University should prohibit the practice by which students sometimes enroll in more than one course scheduled at a given time." Yiannaki stated that it is possible to provide a list of students who register for more than one course scheduled at the same time. After discussion, the committee members were asked to bring pertinent information to the next meeting.

NEW BUSINESS: Dr. Yiannaki brought up an issue suggested by Dr. McBriarty concerning the policy of averaging grades when granting honors. With the present policy of averaging all grades regardless of how far in the past, for YSU students, but not including grades before YSU for transfer students, transfer students have an advantage over YSU students. The committee members will study the policy as presently stated in the University Bulletin, and the issue will be discussed at the next meeting.

The next meeting of the Committee is tentatively scheduled for Monday, November 28, at 3:00 p.m.
