- I. Correction to the Minutes of October 23: Under II., Definite Problems, add <u>4. Science ..... M.S. 631.</u> Land Navigation and Outdoor Survival.
- II The following errors in catalog numbers in the Military Science Department were noted:

"M.S.511 (YSU Catalog) has replaced M.S.620 (A&S course list for area requirements) M.S.630 (YSU Catalog) has replaced M.S.631 (A&S course list for area requirements)"

<u>M.S.511</u> (Basic Leadership and Management) and <u>M.S.701</u> (Organizational Leadership) were questioned as being legitimate social science credits; <u>M.S.631</u> (Land Navigation and Outdoor Survival) as a science credit.

- III. The Committee discussed the problem of how to clear up inconsistencies between the courses which are listed as fulfilling area requirements and the general definition on p. 40 of the Catalog of humanities, social studies and science courses. The general consensus was that to continue to raise questions about specific courses (some examples were cited at the meeting), would be to open up "the can of worms" of what the area requirements should be and we're not ready to do that.
- 'V. The Committee felt that we should begin by establishing a verified master list that would be available to all students. Yiannaki stated that this list should be in the Catalog.
- V. While schools or colleges have the right to establish "higher" standards, they do not have the right to establish lower. A check needs to be made to see if courses that are on the master list, but which schools or colleges do not allow, are typographical errors, oversights or legitimate exclusions.
