

Minutes of YSU Standards and Events Committee  
February 18, 1991

1. Meeting was called to order at 4:05 p.m.
2. Minutes of meeting of February 4, 1991 were approved.
3. Post Secondary Enrollment Option discussion continued. Subcommittee Questionnaire data analysis was presented by Reid. A general finding seemed that faculty perceive the students as more prepared than the students themselves. Copies were given to Yiannaki. Procedural issues were discussed by Yiannaki. Preliminary analysis suggests that YSU's initial moves in this area are working and qualified students are receiving reasonable access and achieving reasonable success. Yiannaki expects more students to achieve access to YSU under this program next academic year. The Subcommittee will continue to monitor the progress of enrolled students. No recommendations for change in approach seem warranted at this time.
4. Ohio Articulation and Transfer Policy materials were distributed. After some general comments it was noted that we need more specific information from Kohut, to include the draft document being formulated by him. Further discussion will be postponed until a future meeting with the draft and/or Kohut available.
5. Mistovich, Chairperson of the University Curriculum Committee, requested that the committee review Criminal Justice's request that course CJ 807 be approved for CR/NC grading. After some discussion, this request was APPROVED. There was concern about the appropriateness of a CR/NC swing course, but this judgment was beyond the charge of the committee and the committee's charge related only to its use as an undergraduate course.
