SUBJECT Minutes of the Monday, March 3 (8 a.m.) Meeting

MEMBERS PRESENT: G. Tribble, D. Rost, R. Tabak, J. Scriven, I. Heal, B. Brothers

1. Minutes of 2/24/86 approved.
2. Members present received the Howard Mettee memo to Brothers indicating a change from the word "inquiry" to "understanding." Committee felt this was a better choice of words.
3. Comments on what Committee desires for other cultural experience:
 - a. I. Heal: another country or subculture within the U.S.; present;
 - b. R. Tabak: other cultures other than Western European; present;
 - c. D. Rost: current; move students out of their shells--may be different for different student (Iranian student for instance);
 - d. G. Tribble: culture different than our mainstream; current.

Consensus seems to be a country or culture other than Western or a U.S. Subculture other than mainstream U.S. history; areas would include humanities or social studies; focus would be on understanding the present either through a twentieth-century period designation or through a survey that includes the twentieth century.
