1. Whitney explained that while HPE 589 was originally intended to meet the general needs of students it may be appropriate for those with physical limitations. It has become a part of the Department's plan to gradually eliminate HPE 614 (Foundations of Physical Education). HPE 589 requires 2 hours of lecture/theory and 2 hours of physical activity and counts as 2 q. h. credit toward general requirement.
2. Fred Owens withdrew his statement from proposed course descriptions of Speech 600 and 650 that grading for the courses will be CR/NC. The statement may be replaced with alternate language by the University Curriculum Division.
