... Both full-time and part-time students are eligible provided that they have a minimum <u>cumulative grade point</u> average of 3.00, earned at least 12 credits in traditionally graded courses taken during the four quarters (including summer) preceding the quarter in which honors are awarded, <u>and be enrolled during the current quarter</u>. <u>Non-matriculated</u>, transient, post-graduate transfer... are not eligible.
