1. Extensive discussion regarding the disregard of the 2/3 conversion rule for the content and education areas. The content areas are social studies, language arts, natural science and math. Two content areas must be taken to secure a degree. The state requirements have, in part, required an increase in total hours. However, particular content areas in combination will give the program well over 124 sh and as high as 150 sh.

2. Education reduced the required hours and requested the content areas review their areas and reduce accordingly.
