Dr. Jenkins presided. The minutes of the November 16, 1987 meeting were approved as submitted.

Dr. Hankins requested reconsideration of his motion from the previous meeting because he saw some ambiguity in it. After discussion, Dr. Hankins moved that the following be adopted in place of his previous motion. Professor Hicken seconded the motion.

The student may appeal any action affecting the grade. Appeals will be heard by the Student Academic Grievance Subcommittee or the Graduate Student Grievance Committee as appropriate.

Motion carried.

Dr. Jenkins reported that Student Services stated that student records concerning disciplinary matters are maintained for four or five years depending on the situation.



It was moved by Mr. Scriven and seconded by Dr. Gill-Wigal that it be recommended to Student Services that the following be inserted in the Student Conduct Code.

All reports of academic dishonesty will be kept on file and will be consulted when students are found to be in violation of other University regulations.
