

MINUTES OF MEETING OF ACADEMIC AFFAIRS COMMITTEE

May 1, 1978

4:00 p.m.

Actions: The following corrections were made concerning the last meeting's minutes:

1. The seminar under the Labor Studies Program was corrected to Seminar 640.
2. Dr. Vogel's memo reflected his thinking instead of "of the committee."
3. The fourth line of the second paragraph was changed to "if they would agree to an advisory committee to that course."
Remove the reference to administration of the course.

Minutes of the last meeting with the above corrections were moved for approval by Mr. Quinby and seconded by Dr. Kougl. Motion passed unanimously.

1. Labor Studies Program

The committee asked Dr. Hill if there had been any communication with Dean Paraska and Mrs. Mackall concerning the Labor Studies Program. Dr. Hill reported that Dean Paraska indicated to him that he is agreeable to the proposal made at the last meeting by the Academic Affairs Committee. Dr. Hill said that Mrs. Mackall would agree if there could be a guarantee that the recommendations of the proposed advisory committee would be followed.

It was suggested by Dr. Richley that the supervisor of the program should have the authority to do what is best and that any committee formed could only be advisory in nature.

Dr. Richley moved approval of the Labor Studies Program with the contingencies listed in the minutes of April 24, 1978. Dr. Kougl seconded. Motion passed unanimously.
