SUBJECT: **Articulation Agreements with Community Colleges**

Transfer of Honors Credit.

1. Upon application, all students from other honors programs who were in good standing relative to their previous program will be admitted into the YSU Honors Degree Program. Honors credit earned at other institutions will be accepted as honors credit and can be used to partially fulfill the requirements for an Honors Degree at YSU subject to review by the Honors Director.
2. To graduate with an Honors Degree, a student must complete at least 20 of the total 36 quarter hours of honors credit from YSU, fulfill the depth and breadth requirements of the Honors Degree Program, and complete a senior thesis in the major discipline. (For more details consult with the Honors Director.)
3. Students who transfer into the YSU Honors Degree program have all the rights and privileges granted to its members, i.e., honors housing, priority registration, use of honors facilities, etc.
