 - 1. Under the quarter system, the program was 226 qh and following the 2/3's rule, it would be 151 sh. However they have reduced it to 141-145 sh.
 - 2. Give evidence of what other schools with this program are doing in regard to total hours of the program. J.Elias offered to investigate this issue.
 - 3. A statement would have to appear in the catalog which states this program could not be completed in 4 years.
- 119 Middle Childhood Education BS on hold
 - 1. The total number of hours is 140-147. Review by the content departments must be considered, presentation of the guidelines which indicate the total of hours is required for the dregree and/or a review of other programs.
 - 2. A statement would have to appear in the catalog which states this program could not be completed in four years.
- 124 Finance BS returned
 - Concern with the number of 4 sh courses in the major. 5 of the 6 courses in the major are four hour courses. This does not follow the Academic Q2S conversion recommendations. Statement was received from Dr. Woodlock stating the accreditation report recommended a reduction in course preparation for the purpose of allowing faculty the opportunity to do more research
 - 2. A breakdown of other programs which have 4 sh classes was provided. It indicated that Cleveland State has 4 courses which are 4 sh.
