Miss Valentine Potor, who formerly taught at Berea College, has been appointed Assistant Professor in Mathematics. Dr. Robert L. Blair, of the English and Speech Department, has been replaced by Professor Clair Mart Hughey, who is on leave of absence from State Teachers College, California, Pennsylvania. A number of part-time teachers have also been added to the faculty, among them Mr. M. L. Cabot and Miss Mary Haddow in the field of Education, Miss Elizabeth Miller in the Speech Department, and Dr. Foster C. Anderson, who is teaching Philosophy.
